GRADUATE PROGRAM

- have successfully completed a relevant undergraduate program at a recognized university or college;
- have applied to be a full-time student in a post-graduate degree program in turfgrass/agronomy management;
- intend to continue in a graduate program toward a masters degree in turfgrass/agronomy management;
- have experience in the game of golf and a desire to pursue a career in the golf industry;
- have regularly participated in community and/or extracurricular activities;
- are a Canadian citizen or landed immigrant.

UNDERGRADUATE PROGRAM

- show a minimum average of 75% in the last two years of high school, or CEGEP, and have attained a graduation diploma (minimum grade 12) or;
- have completed at least one full year in a post-secondary degree/diploma program at a recognized institution and show a minimum average of 75% in each year of the program;
- have experience in the game of golf and a desire to pursue a career in the golf industry;
- have regularly participated in community and/or extracurricular activities;
- are a Canadian citizen or landed immigrant
