## Guidance

If reporting a Human or Domestic Animal Incident, try to answer the following questions to the best of your ability. Was anyone injured? If the answer is “yes”, then how many people or animals were injured? Was treatment or hospitalization required? How long did treatment or hospitalization last? What symptoms did the customer report? How long did they last?

If reporting an Environmental Incident, try to answer the following questions to the best of your ability. What specific species was injured due to the pesticide application? How many of them were damaged? Was anything else involved?

If reporting the results of a Technical Paper for a company sponsored pesticide study then please provide the following information. What is the Title of the document? Who is the author? Is the information Confidential?

Unexpected packaging failures are also to be reported. This does not include failures due to mishandling or unusual circumstances. It only involves a packaging failure that is unexpected. In this case, please report what was noticed.
